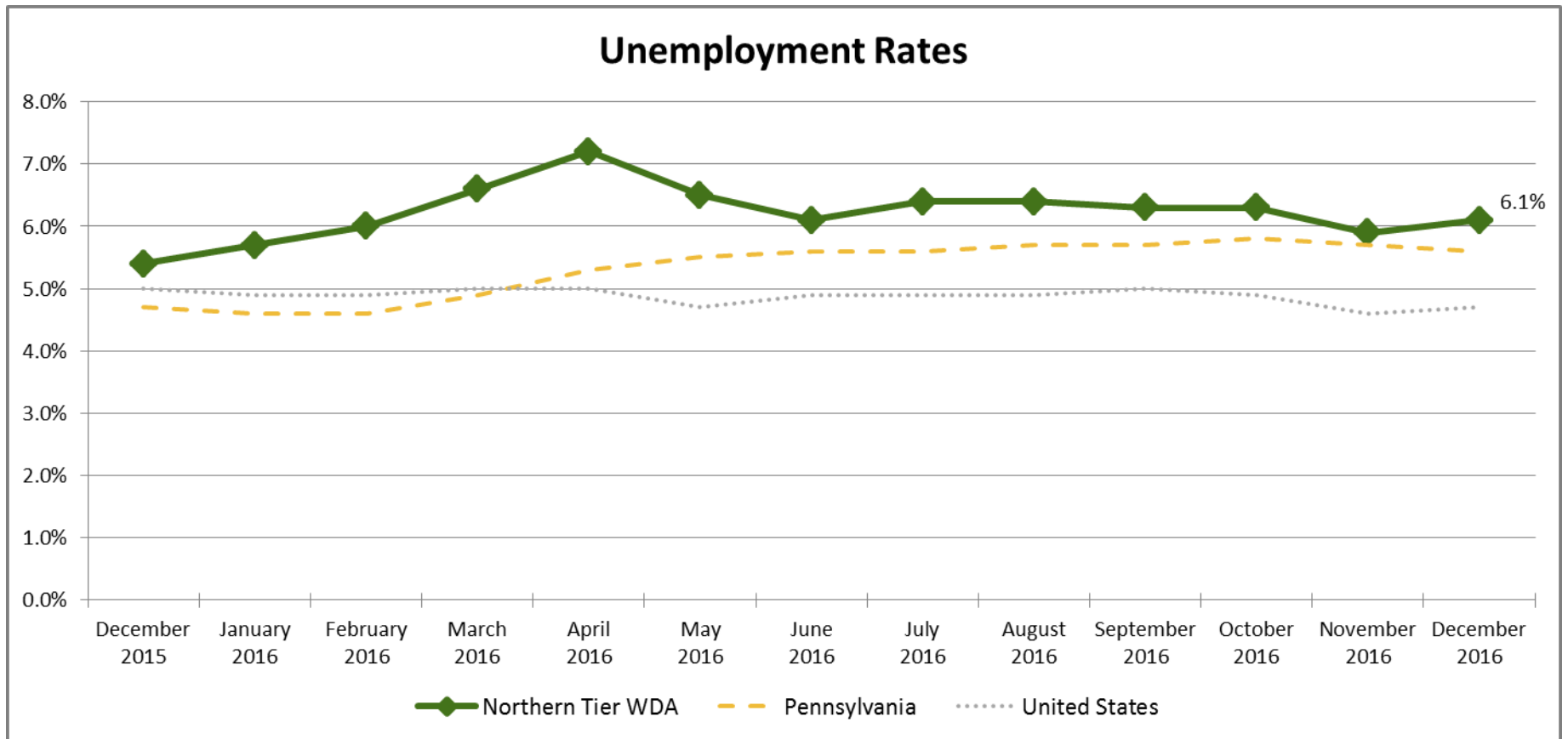

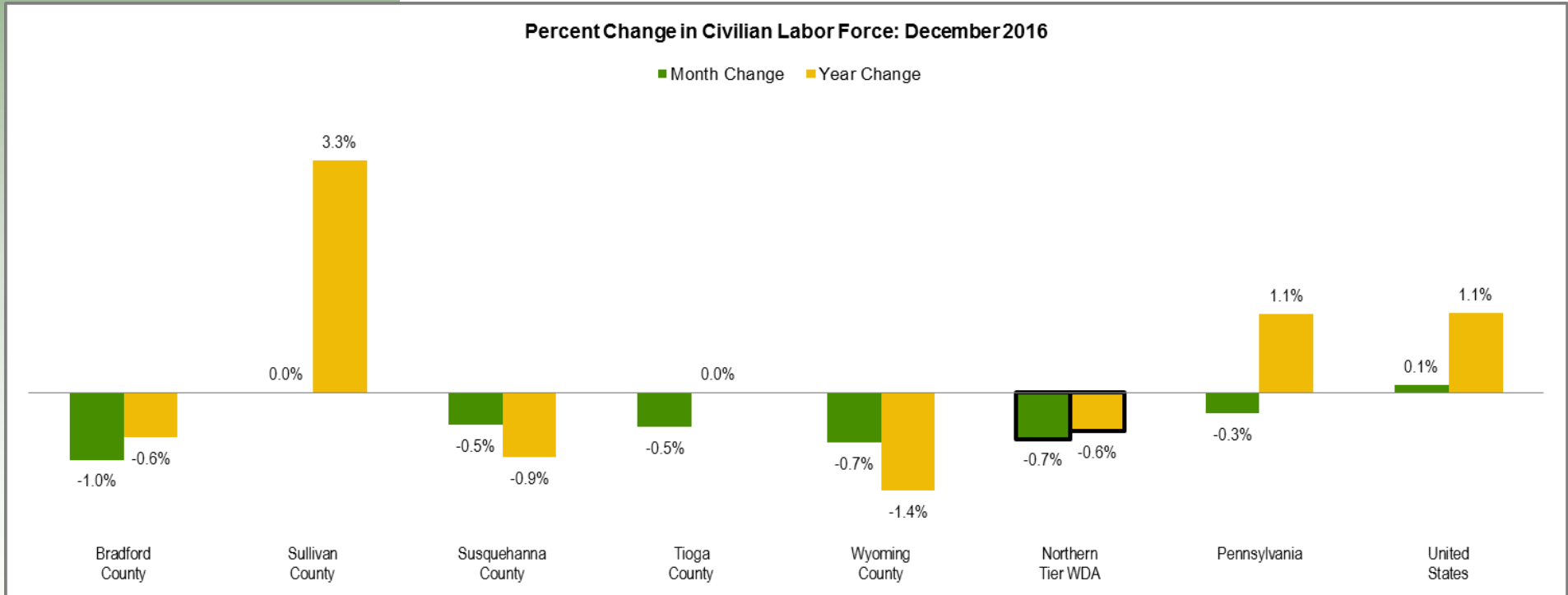


**Civilian Labor Force**

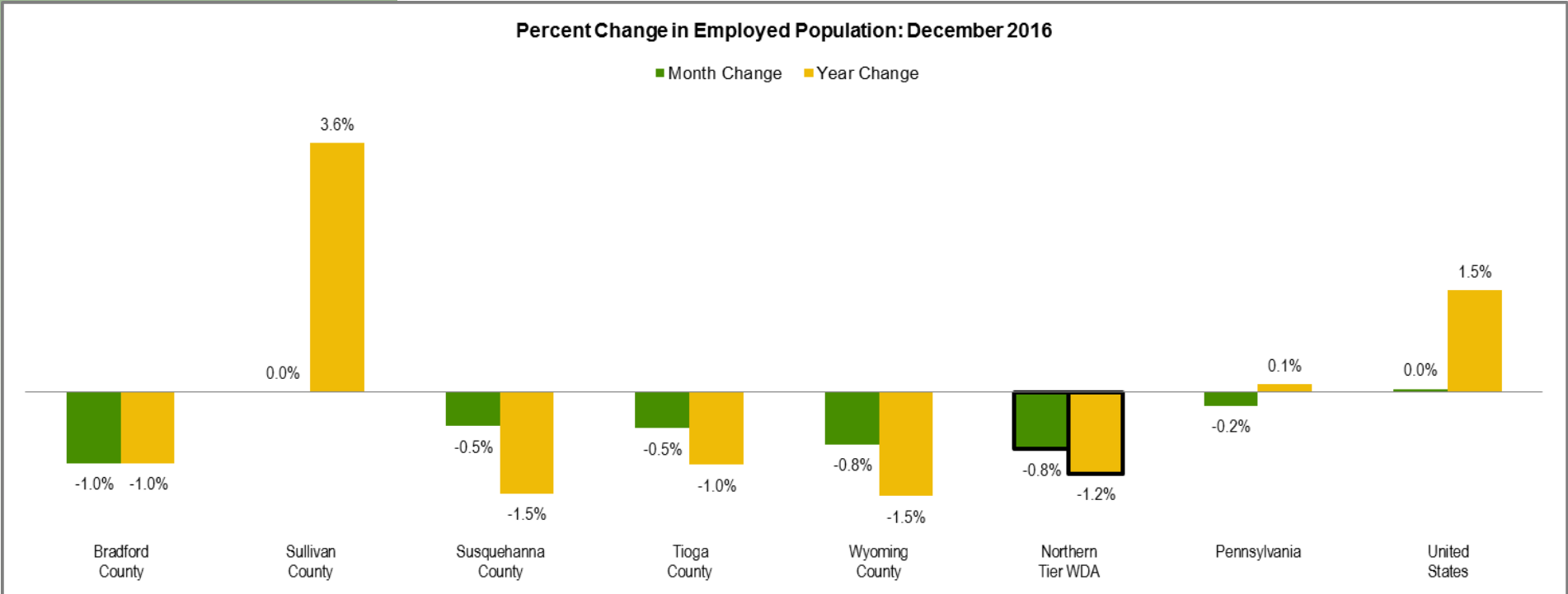

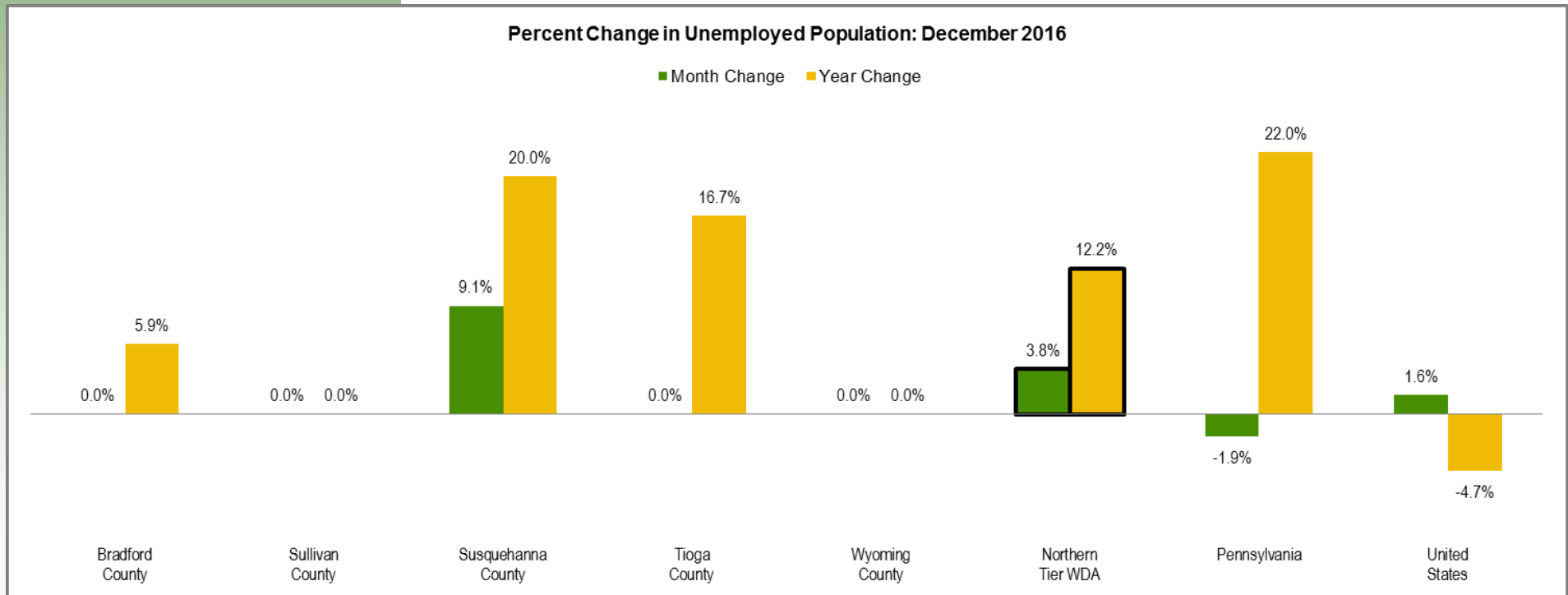


**Unemployed Population**
