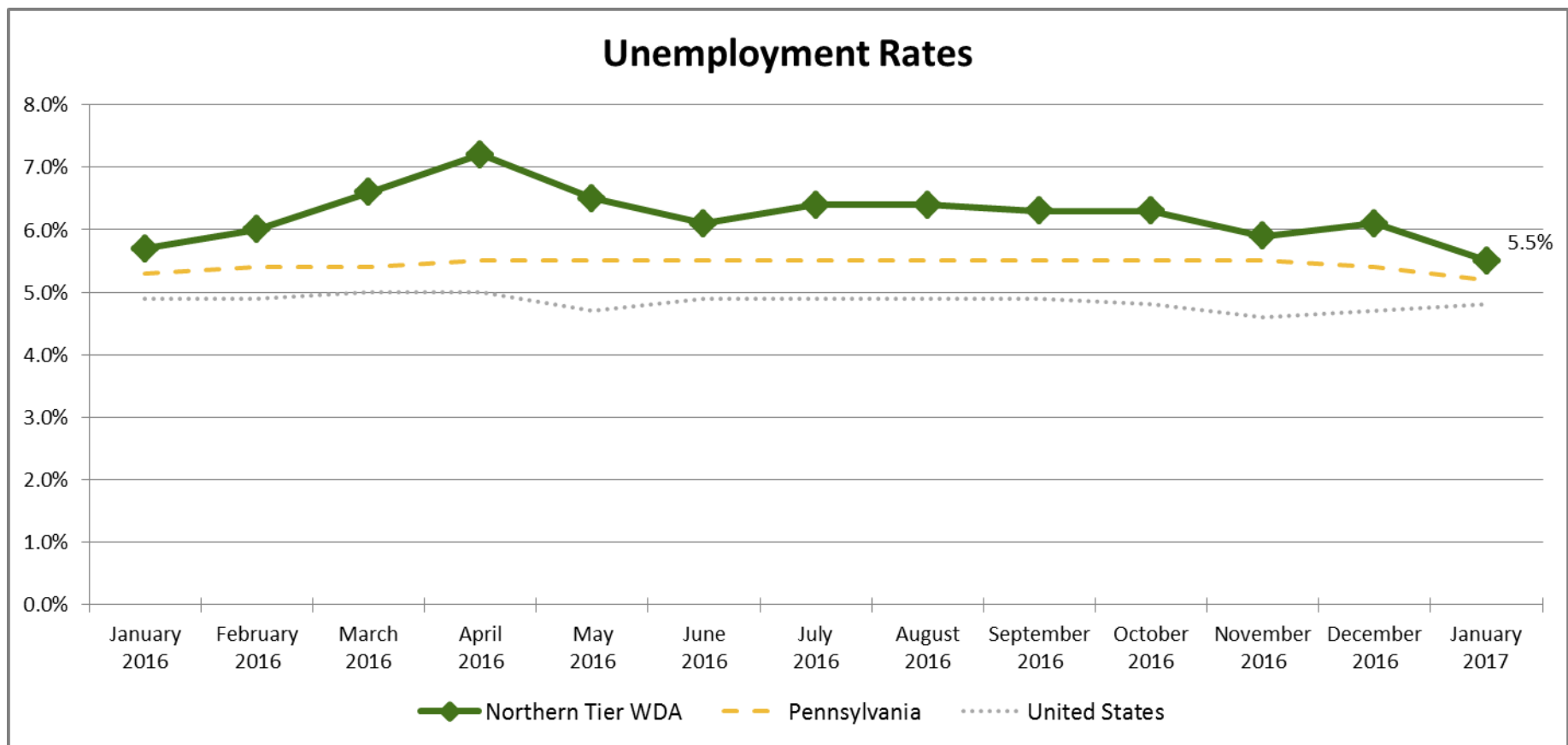

Civilian Labor Force

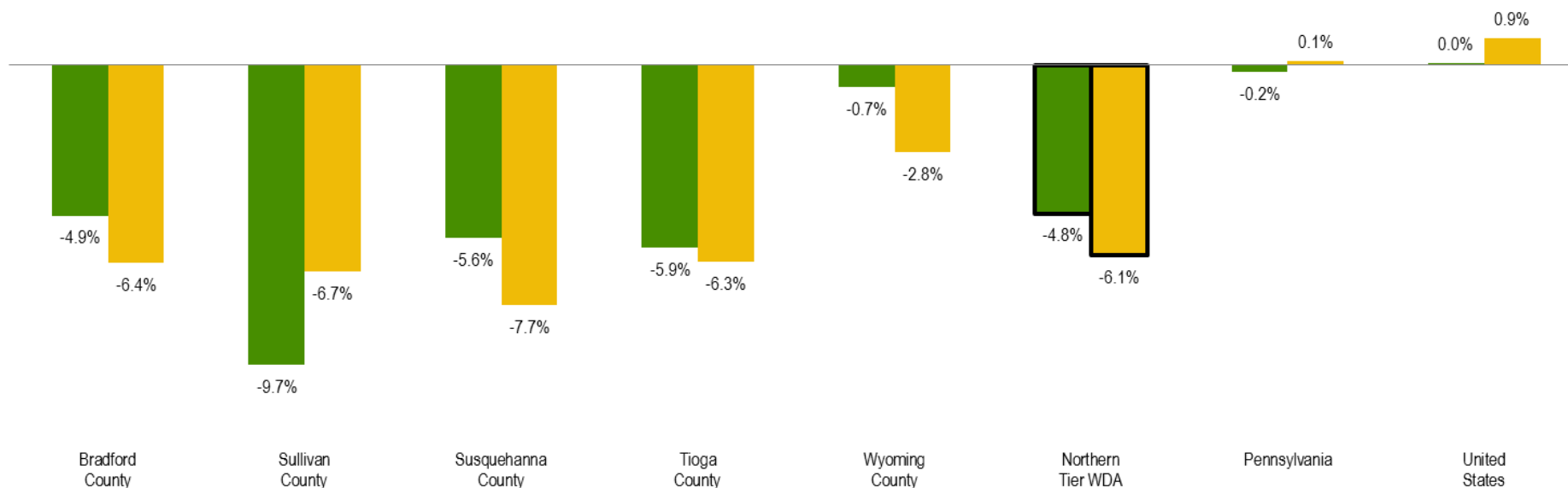

■ Month Change ■ Year Change



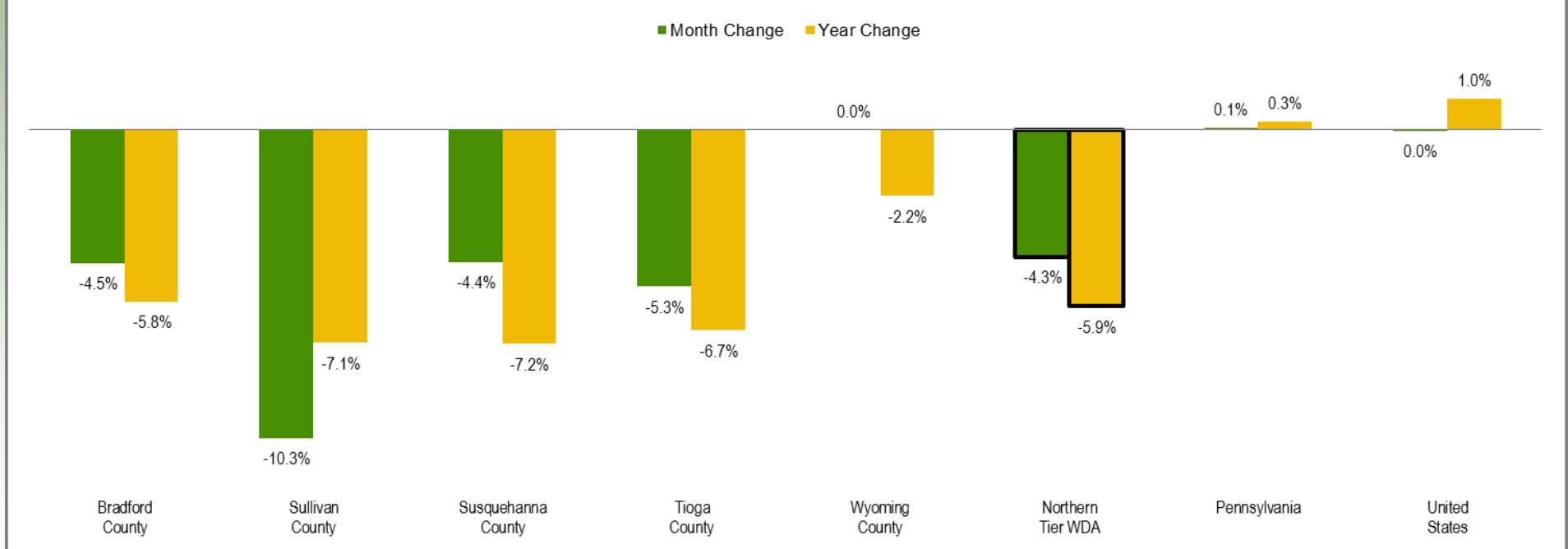

Percent Change in Employed Population: January 2017



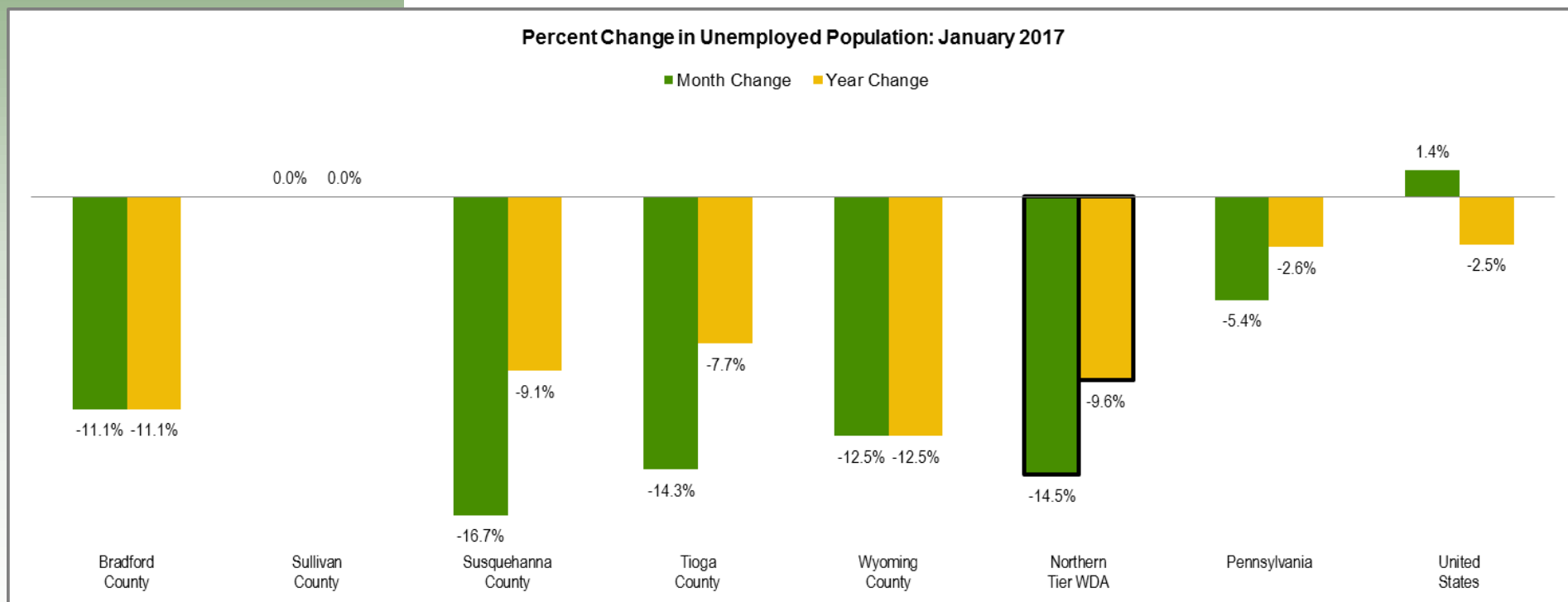
