

Nurse Aide Instructor Certification

Teaching the Educator Program

Purpose of Training:

This Workshop serves to facilitate the process of transitioning professional nurses from the role of practitioner into the role of instructor of nurse aide training. Nurses are expected to leave the workshop prepared to successfully teach Nurse Aide (N.A.) training in accordance with the federal and state legislative requirements—OBRA and Act 14, respectively.

Who is eligible to receive training?

Individuals with at least two years of experience as a RN/LPN and at least one year in the provision of long-term care facility that are employed in Bradford, Sullivan, Susquehanna, Tioga, and Wyoming Counties. Note: Eligible participants that do not meet the requirements of having one years experience in long term care may still attend but will be certified to teach only after that requirement is fulfilled.

What will it cost you?

The total cost of this training is \$200 per person. However, with the use of the Healthcare Industry Partnership Worker Training Grant funds, **Health Care employers are eligible for training at a reduced cost of \$50 per person.** All materials, refreshments, and lunches will be provided. The employer is expected to cover the participants' salary during time away from work and costs associated with replacing the employees while he/she attends the program.

Who will deliver the training?

The training will be delivered by Penn State University and Pennsylvania Department of Education instructors.
