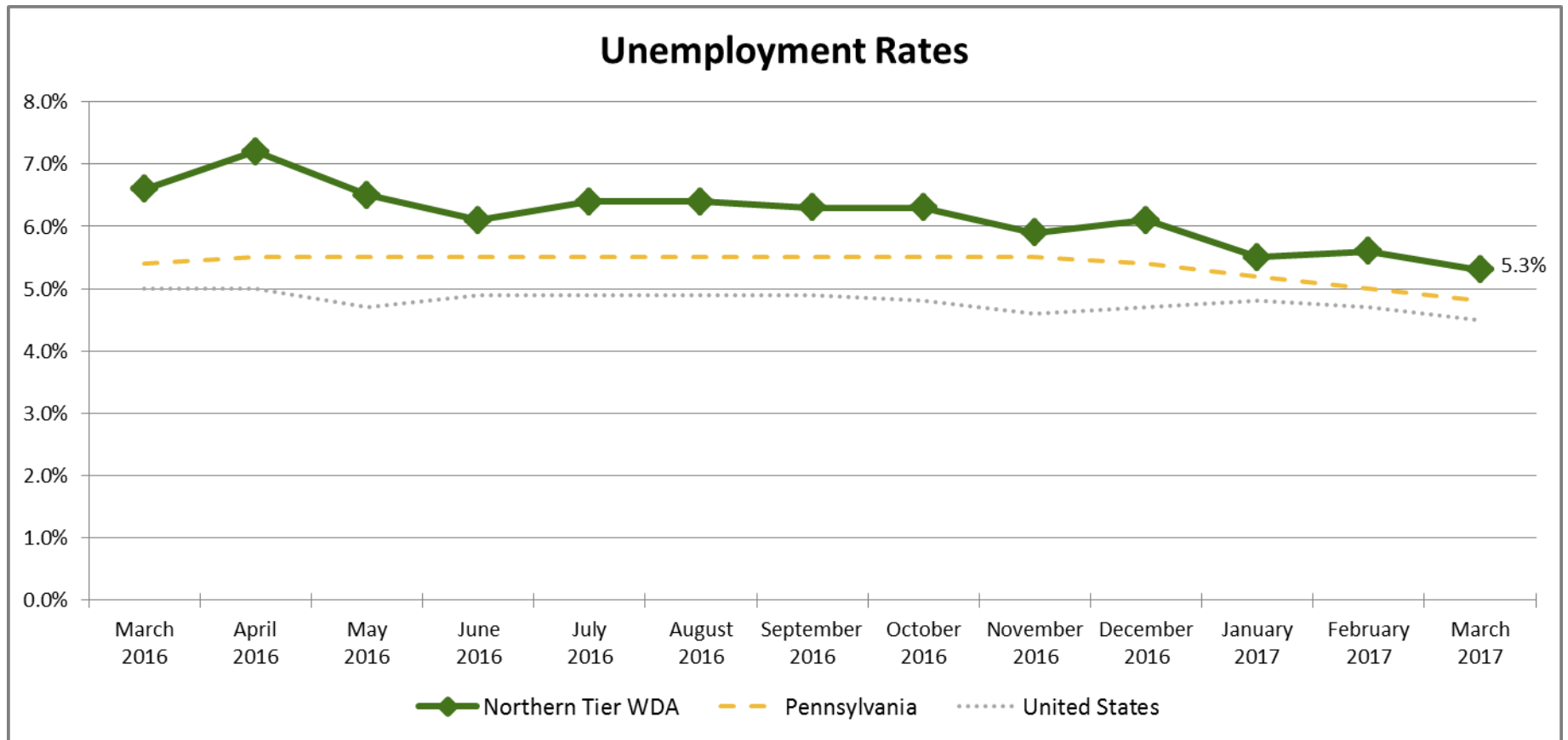

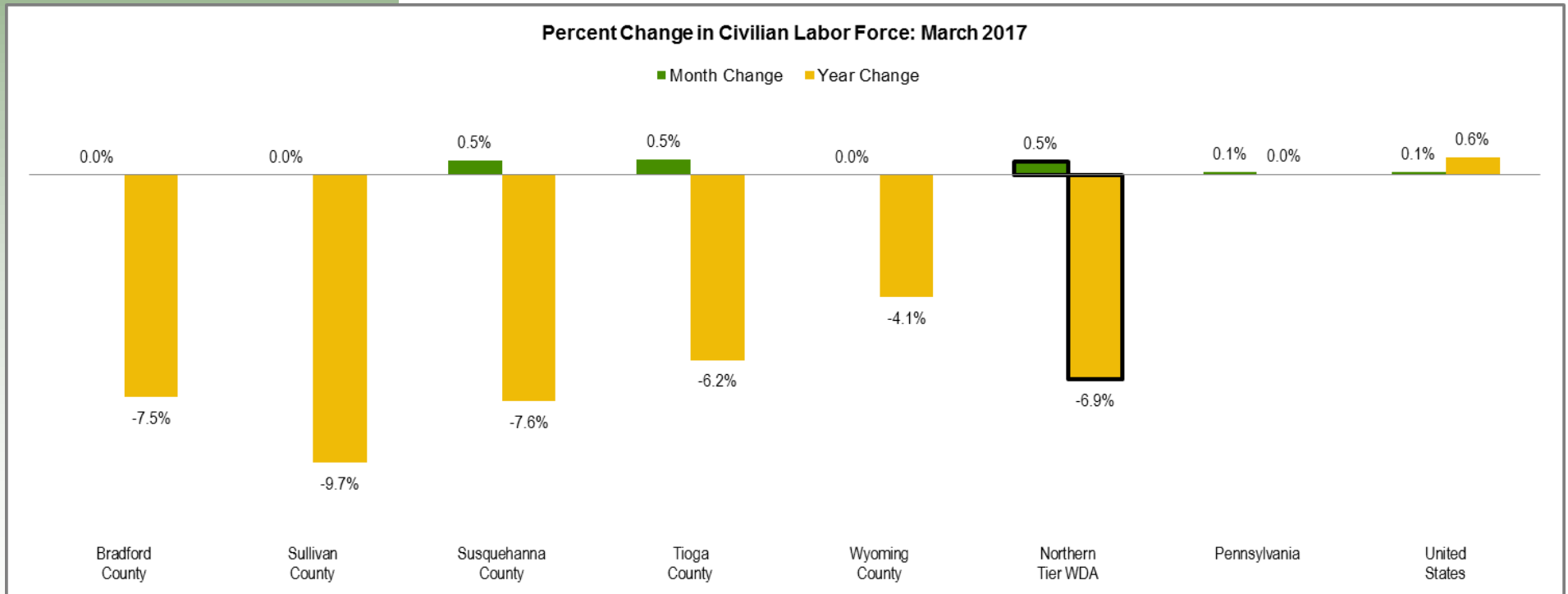


Civilian Labor Force

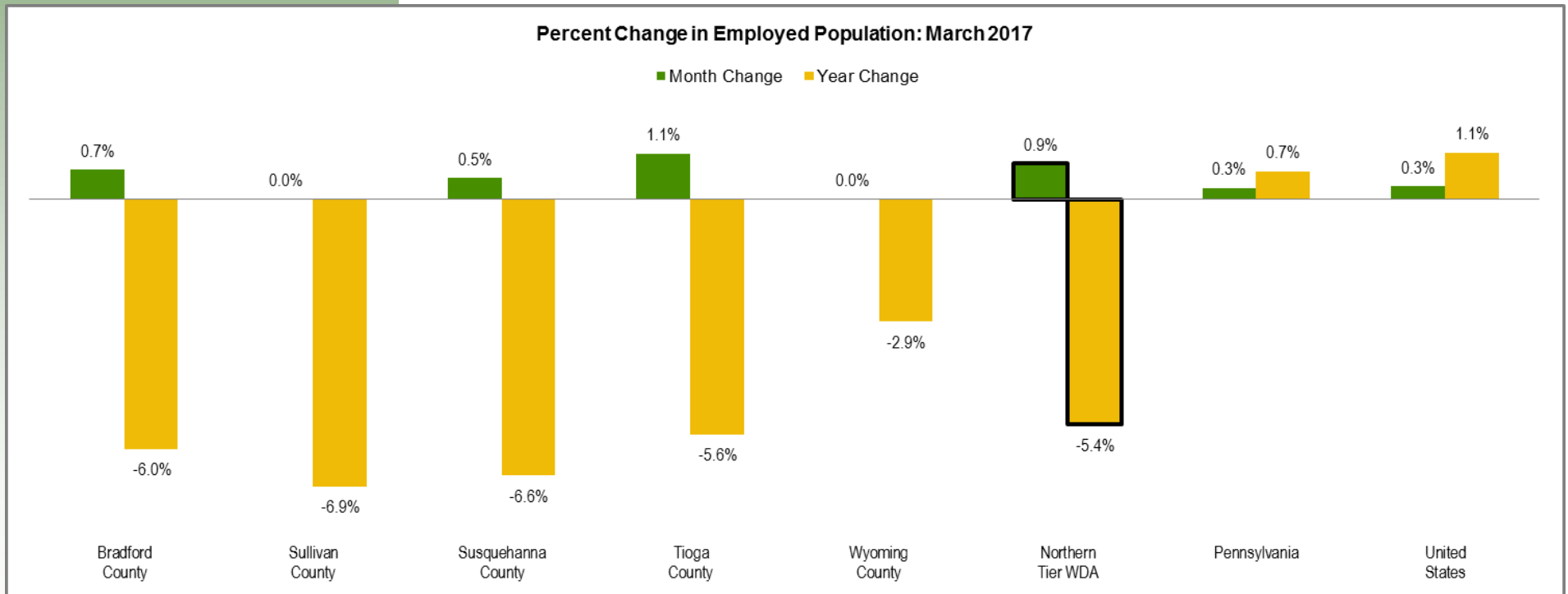

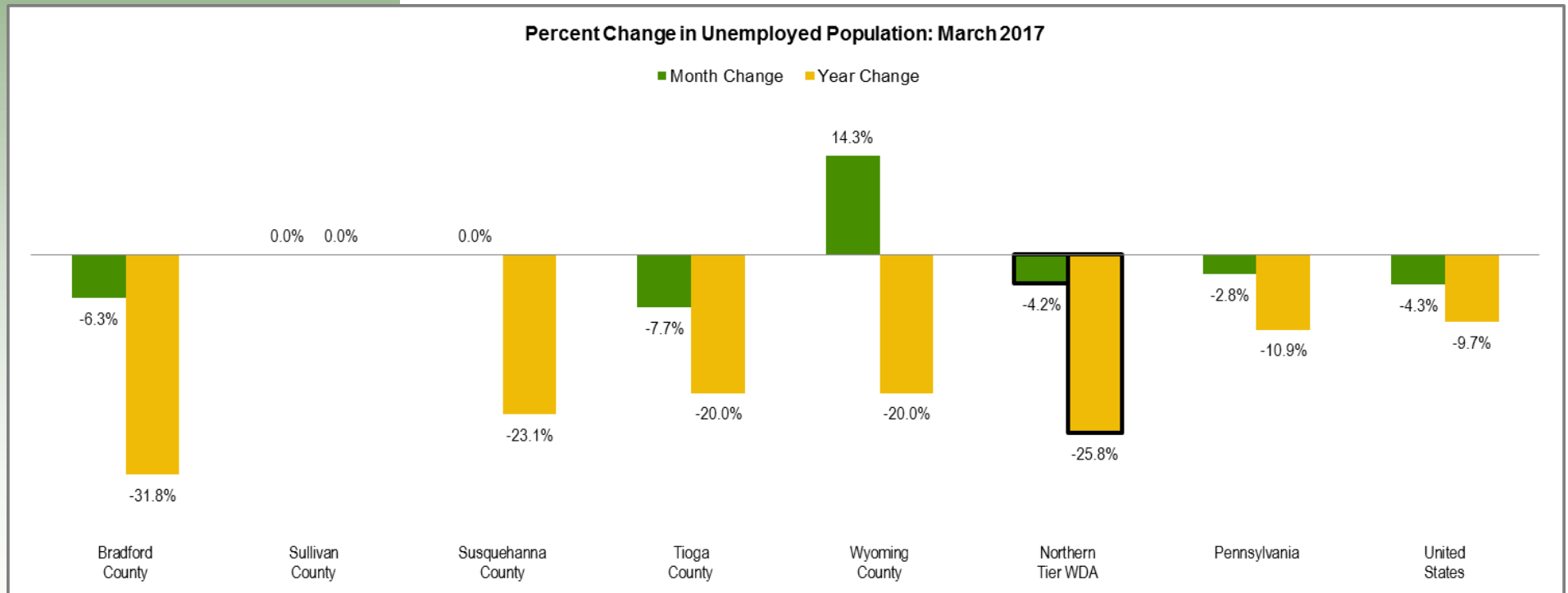
