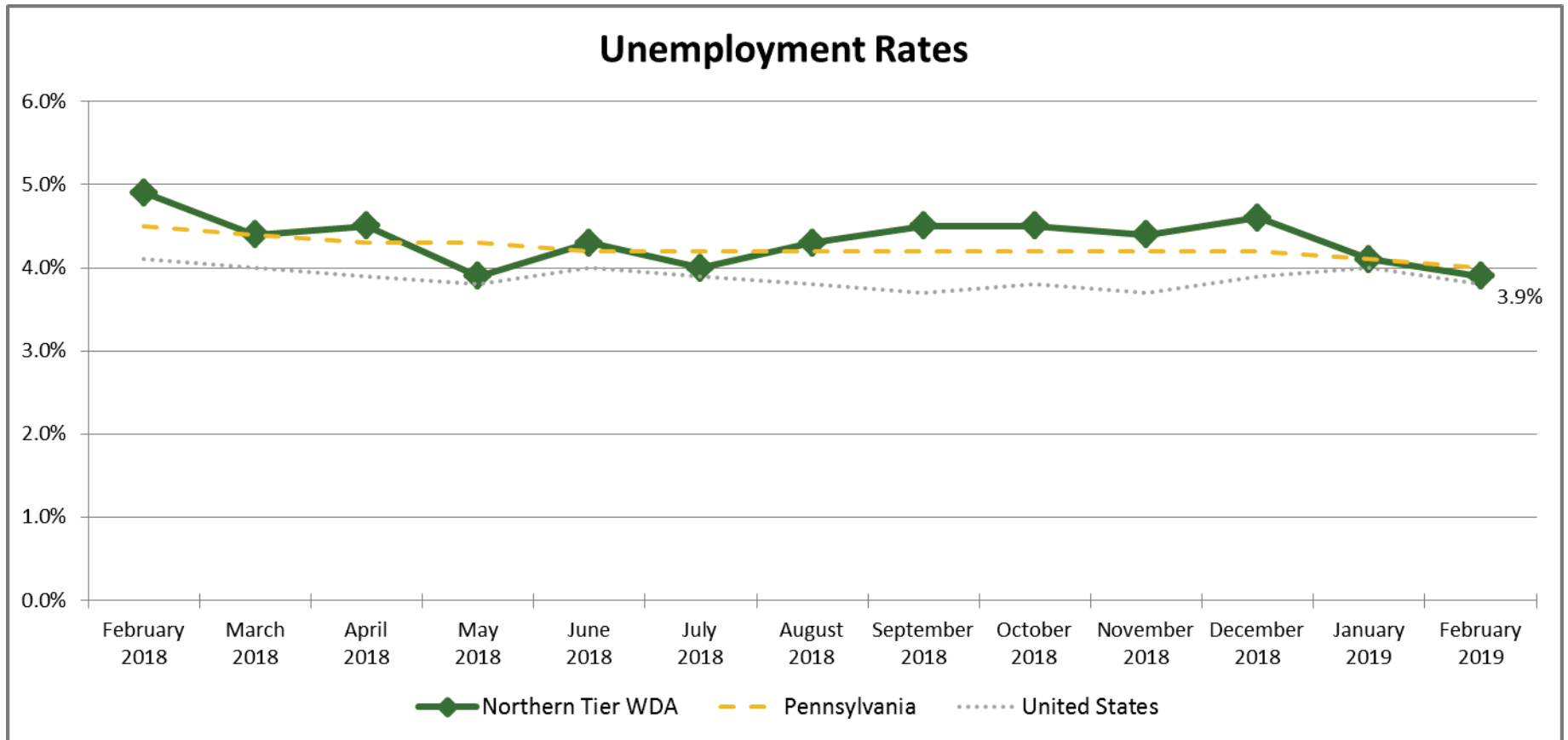

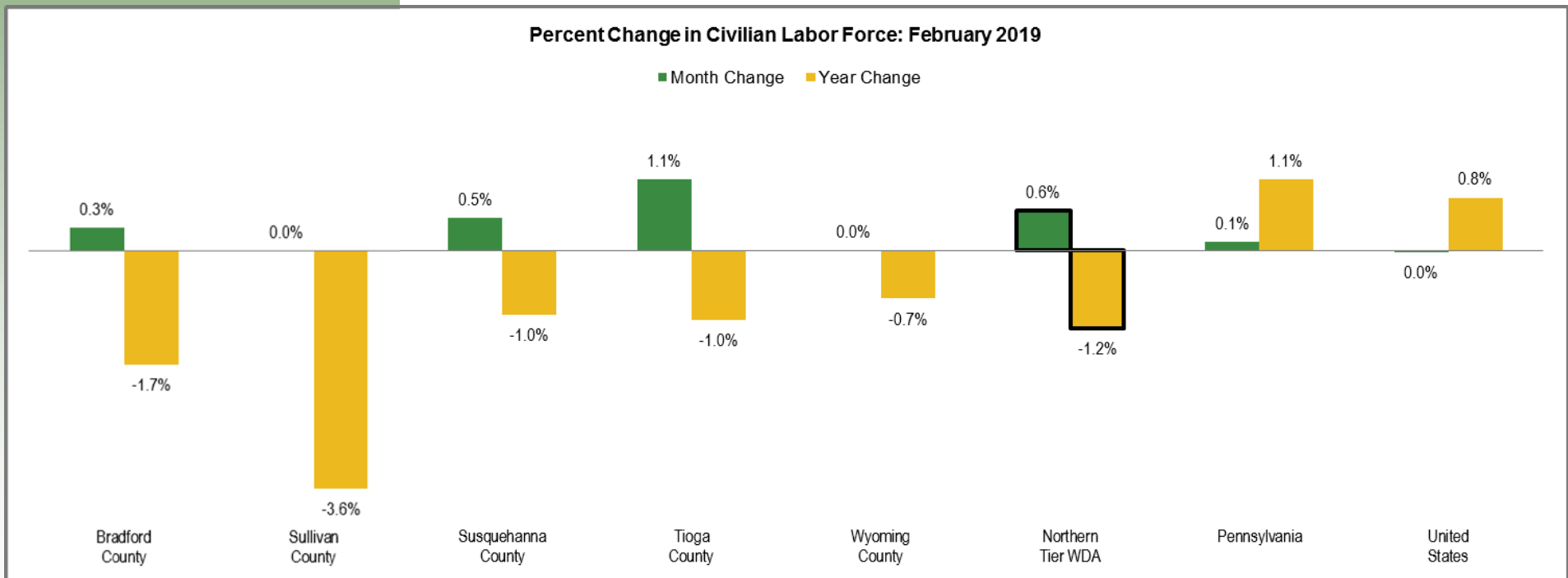


**Civilian Labor Force**

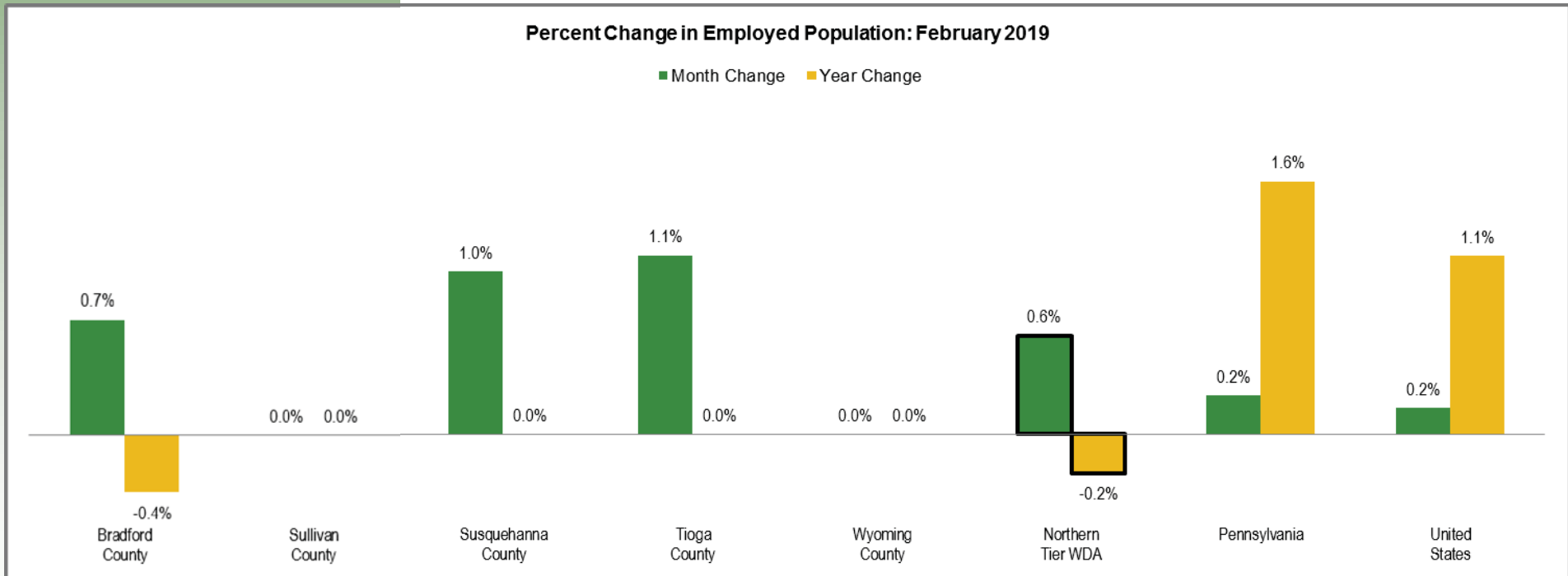


### Employed Population

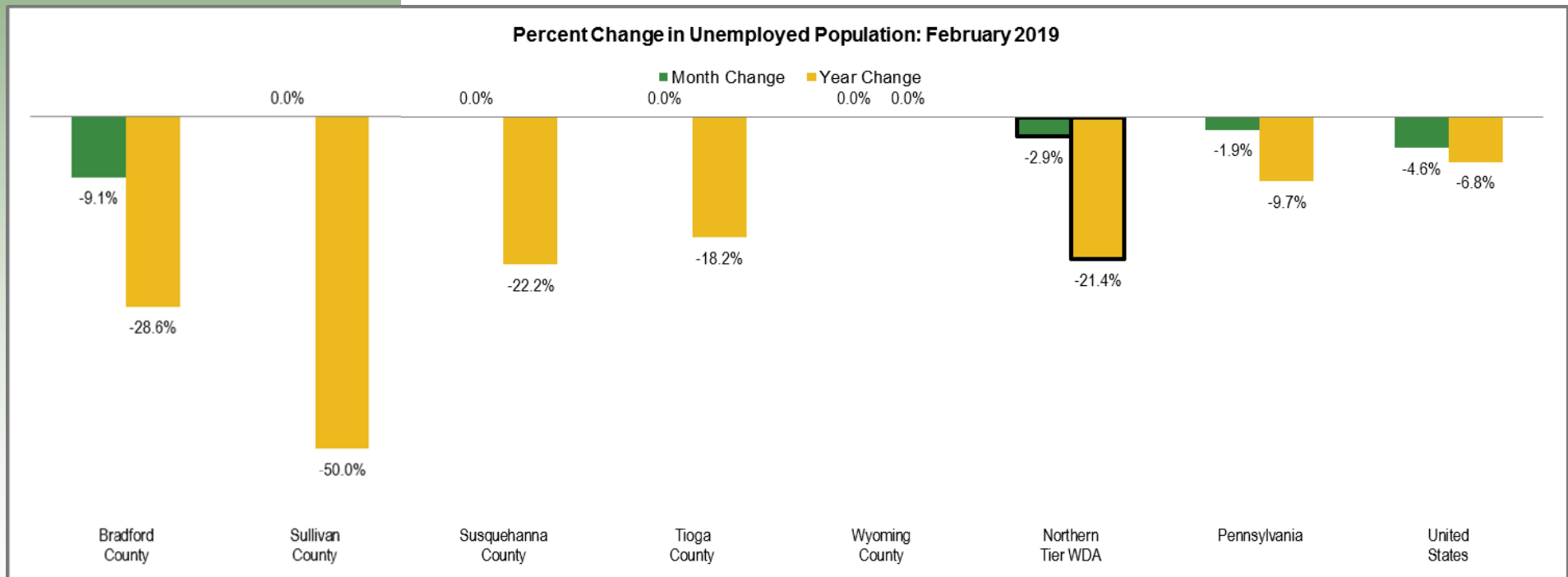


### Unemployed Population

| Pennsylvania         | 4.0%          | 4.1%         | 4.5%          |
| United States        | 3.8%          | 4.0%         | 4.1%          |
